\_\_\_\_\_ The Gospel of the promised Messiah

**Matthew 1:21** She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.  
20 - 30% is unique to Matthew. Written A.D. 60-70

\_\_\_\_\_ The Gospel of the suffering Servant

**Mark 10:45** For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.  
5 - 10% is unique to Mark. Written A.D. 55-60

\_\_\_\_\_ The Gospel of the perfect Savior

**Luke 19:10** For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.  
55% is unique to Luke. Written A.D. 60-62

\_\_\_\_\_ The Gospel of the divine Son

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.  
92% is unique to John. Written A.D. 90-95

### Jewish Festivals:

**John 2:13** The Passover of the Jews was near, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

**John 7:2** Now the feast of the Jews, the Feast of Booths, was near.

**John 10:22** At that time the Feast of the Dedication took place at Jerusalem.

### Jewish Geography:

**John 4:5-6** He came to a city of Samaria...<sup>6</sup> and Jacob's well was there.

**John 9:7** [Jesus] said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam".

**John 10:23** It was winter, and Jesus was walking in the temple in the portico of Solomon.

**John 18:1** He went forth with His disciples over the ravine of the Kidron, where there was a garden.

**John 19:17** They took Jesus...to the place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha.

### Jewish Traditions:

**John 1:38** They said to [Jesus], "Rabbi (which translated means Teacher), where are You staying?"

**John 1:41** We have found the Messiah (which translated means Christ).

**John 4:9** How is it that You, being a Jew, ask me for a drink?...For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.

**John 1:14** **We saw His glory**, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**John 6:9** There is a lad here who has **five barley loaves** and two fish, but what are these for so many people?

**John 12:3** Mary...anointed the feet of Jesus....and **the house was filled with the fragrance** of the perfume.

**John 18:10** Simon Peter...struck the high priest's slave, and cut off his right ear; and the slave's name was **Malchus**.

**John 19:34** But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately **blood and water** came out.

**John 20:7** [He] saw the linen wrappings...and the face-cloth which had been on His head....**rolled up** in a place by itself.

**John 21:11** Simon Peter went up and drew the net to land, full of large fish, **a hundred and fifty-three**.

**Matthew 26:20** Now when evening came, Jesus was reclining at the table with the twelve disciples.

**John 13:23** There was reclining on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus loved.

**John 13:24-25** Simon Peter gestured to him, and said to him, "Tell us who it is of whom He is speaking." He, leaning back thus on Jesus' bosom, said to Him, "Lord, who is it?"

**John 15:15** No longer do I call you slaves...but I have called you friends.

**John 19:26-27** When Jesus then saw His mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing nearby, He said to His mother, 'Woman, behold, your son!' Then He said to the disciple, 'Behold, your mother!'

**John 21:7** Therefore that disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord."

**John 21:2,20,24** Simon Peter, and Thomas....and Nathanael...and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of His disciples were together...<sup>20</sup> Peter, turning around, saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following them; the one who also had leaned back on His bosom at the supper and said, "Lord, who is the one who betrays You?"....<sup>24</sup> This is the disciple who is testifying to these things and wrote these things.

**1 John 1:1** What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, what we have looked at and touched with our hands, concerning the Word of Life.
