Acts 1:14 They had one mind. **Acts 2: 42** They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. **Acts 4:32** Those who believed were of one heart and soul. **Acts 5:12** They were all with one accord. **Acts 8:1** The church in Jerusalem. **Acts 8:3** Saul began ravaging the church. **Acts 11:22** News of this reached the church. **Acts 11:26** Barnabas and Saul met with the church in Antioch. **Acts 12:1** Herod arrested some who belonged to the church. **Acts 12:5** The church was earnestly praying. **Acts 14:27** They gathered the church together. **Acts 15:3** The church sent them on their way. **Acts 15:4** They were welcomed by the church in Jerusalem

Acts 1:15 Peter stood up in the midst of the brethren (a gathering of about **one hundred and twenty persons**).

Acts 2:41 that day there were added about **three thousand souls**.

Acts 5:4 Many of those who heard the message believed; and the number of the men came to be about **five thousand**.

Acts 5:11,13-14 And great fear came over the whole church, and over all who heard of these things...¹³ But none of the rest dared to associate with them; however, the people held them in high esteem. ¹⁴ And all the more believers in the Lord...were constantly added to their number.

Romans 16:1-2 I commend to you our sister Phoebe, who is a servant of the church which is at Cenchrea; that you receive her in the Lord in a manner worthy of the saints.

To be a Christian is to belong to a church. No one gets saved and then wanders around by him or herself, thinking about whether to join a church...Looking to Christ as Lord means being united to Christ's people. Matthew 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 10:32-33 Everyone therefore who shall confess Me before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven. ³³ But whoever shall deny Me before men, I will also deny him before My Father who is in heaven.

1 John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome.

- To collectively remember Him in _____

Luke 22:19-20 And when He had taken some bread and given thanks, He broke it and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” ²⁰ And in the same way He took the cup after they had eaten, saying, “This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood.

1 Corinthians 11: 27-28 Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. ²⁸ But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

4. Devotion to the groom: _____

Romans 12:1 Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

Colossians 3:23-24 Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve.
