- _____ Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. v12

Isaiah 1:18 Though your sins are as scarlet, they will be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they will be like wool.

Isaiah 43:25 I am the one who wipes out your transgressions for My own sake, and I will not remember your sins.

Psalms 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
