1. Understand His _____ — Jesus is God v1-5

_____ (Logos, λόγος): is the absolute self-revelation of God, in whom all His purposes, plans, and promises are perfectly realized.

Hebrews 1:1-2 God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, ² in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Revelation 19:13 His name is called The Word of God.

Revelation 1:8 I am the Alpha and the Omega.

John 1:18 No one has ever seen God, but God the One and Only, who is at the Father's side, has made him known. (NIV)

John 8:58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."

JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES—ARE THEY CHRISTIANS?

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, **and the Word was a god.** (New World Translation)

The “beginning” referred to in this verse cannot mean “the beginning” of God, because God had no beginning. Jehovah God is “from everlasting to everlasting.” (Psalm 90:1, 2) However, the Word, Jesus Christ, did have a beginning. **What Does the Bible Really Teach**

- He is _____ v3

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Psalms 33:6 By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, And by the breath of His mouth all their host.

Isaiah 44:24 Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, and the one who formed you from the womb, “I, the Lord, am the maker of all things, Stretching out the heavens by Myself And spreading out the earth all alone,

1 Corinthians 8:6 yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom are all things and we exist for Him; and one Lord, Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we exist through Him.

Hebrews 1:2 in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Colossians 1:16 For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.

Romans 11:36 For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him *be* the glory forever. Amen.

Acts 17:24-25 The God who made the world and all things in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in temples made with hands; ²⁵ nor is He served by human hands, as though He needed anything, since He Himself gives to all people life and breath and all things;

Exodus 3:14 God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.”

Psalms 36:9 For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.

John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

1 John 1:5 This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all.

Matthew 4:16 The people who were sitting in darkness saw a great Light, and those who were sitting in the land and shadow of death, upon them a Light dawned.

Luke 1:78-79 Because of the tender mercy of our God, With which the Sunrise from on high will visit us, ⁷⁹ To shine upon those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.”

John 3:19 This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

1 Corinthians 2:14 But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.
