**Luke 7:26** But what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I say to you, and one who is more than a prophet.

**Luke 16:16** The Law and the Prophets were proclaimed until John; since that time the gospel of the kingdom of God has been preached, and everyone is forcing his way into it.

**John 10:41** Many came to Him and were saying, "While John performed no sign, yet everything John said about this man was true."

**John 5:35** He was the lamp that was burning and was shining and you were willing to rejoice for a while in his light.

**Isaiah 49:6** It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also make You a light of the nations so that My salvation may reach to the end of the earth.

**John 12:46** I have come as Light into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness.

**Acts 4:16-17** In the generations gone by He permitted all the nations to go their own ways;<sup>17</sup> and yet He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did good and gave you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, satisfying your hearts with food and gladness.

**Romans 1:20** For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

**Romans 2:14-15** For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these, not having the Law, are a law to themselves,<sup>15</sup> in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them,

**2 Corinthians 4:3-4** And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing,<sup>4</sup> in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving so that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

**John 3:19** This is the judgment, that the Light has come into the world, and men loved the darkness rather than the Light, for their deeds were evil.

**Matthew 21:38** But when the vine-growers saw the son, they said among themselves, 'This is the heir; come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.'

**Isaiah 53:3** He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

**Acts 7:51-52** You men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears are always resisting the Holy Spirit; you are doing just as your fathers did. <sup>52</sup> "Which one of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? They killed those who had previously announced the coming of the Righteous One, whose betrayers and murderers you have now become.

b) Choose to \_\_\_\_\_ v12

**1 John 3:1** See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and such we are.

**1 John 5:1** Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him.

**John 6:40** For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who beholds the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day.

**Romans 10:9** If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

**James 1:18** In the exercise of His will He brought us forth by the word of truth, so that we would be a kind of first fruits among His creatures.

**Titus 3:5** He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit.
