LUKE 24:1-12, 36-49

1 Corinthians 15:14, 17, 19-20 If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain...¹⁷ and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins...¹⁹ If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied.
²⁰ But now Christ has been raised from the dead.

1. I am _____ v1-10

24:4 While they were perplexed about this....

Acts 2:24 But God raised Him up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him to be held in its power.
John 1:4 In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.

Matthew 17:22-23 And while they were gathering together in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men;²³ and they will kill Him, and He will be raised on the third day." And they were deeply grieved.

Mark 9:31-32 The Son of Man is to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him; and when He has been killed, He will rise three days later."³² But they did not understand this statement, and they were afraid to ask Him.

Luke 9:44-45 Let these words sink into your ears; for the Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men."⁴⁵ But they did not understand this statement, and it was concealed from them so that they would not perceive it; and they were afraid to ask Him about this statement.

Mark 16:8 They went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had gripped them.

2. I am _____ v11

24:11 But these words appeared to them as nonsense, and they would not believe them.

1 Corinthians 2:14 But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

3. I am _____ v12

24:12 But Peter got up and ran to the tomb; stooping and looking in, he saw the linen wrappings only; and he went away to his home, marveling at what had happened.

John 20:9-10 For as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that He must rise again from the dead.¹⁰ So the disciples went away again to their own homes.

4. I am _____ v36-40

24:38 And He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?"

John 20:27 Then He said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing."

5. I am _____ v41-43

24:41 While they still could not believe it because of their joy and amazement, He said to them, "Have you anything here to eat?"

Mathew 28:17 When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some were doubtful.

24:45 Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

The seed of the woman **Genesis 3:15** And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise you on the head, and you shall bruise him on the heel.

First animal sacrifice **Genesis 3:21** The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

Jesus is the true ark **Genesis 6 & 1 Peter 3:18-21**

Jesus is the substitute **Genesis 22:13-14** Then Abraham raised his eyes and looked, and behold, behind him a ram caught in the thicket by his horns; and Abraham went and took the ram and offered him up for a burnt offering in the place of his son. Abraham called the name of that place "The Lord Will Provide".

Jesus is the Passover fulfilled **Exodus 11**

Jesus is the lamb & the scapegoat on the Day of Atonement **Leviticus 16**

OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECIES ABOUT HIS FIRST COMING

Descendent of David **Isaiah 11:1** **Born of a virgin** **Isaiah 7:14** **Born in Bethlehem** **Micah 5:2**

Earthly ministry **Isaiah 35:5** Then the eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. Then the lame will leap like a deer, and the tongue of the mute will shout for joy. **Isaiah 61:1** The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, Because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives. (see **Matthew 11:3-5**)

He enters Jerusalem on a donkey **Zechariah 9:9** **Betrayed by a friend** **Psalms 41:9** **Sold for 30 pieces of silver** **Zechariah 11:12-13**

His humiliation **Isaiah 50:6** I gave My back to those who strike Me, and My cheeks to those who pluck out the beard; I did not cover My face from humiliation and spitting.

Crucifixion **Psalms 22:16-18** They pierced my hands and my feet. I can count all my bones. They look, they stare at Me; they divide My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots. **Isaiah 53:5-6** But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. All of us like sheep have gone astray each of us has turned to his own way; but the Lord has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him. **Psalms 69:21** They also gave me gall for my food and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

Resurrection **Psalms 16:10** For You will not abandon my soul to Sheol; nor will You allow Your Holy One to undergo decay.

OLD TESTAMENT APPEARANCES OF CHRIST

Exodus 3:2,6 The angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush...Then Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God. **Genesis 32:24,30** Then Jacob was left alone, and a man wrestled with him until daybreak.... So Jacob named the place Peniel, for he said, "I have seen God face to face, yet my life has been preserved." **Daniel 4:24-25** "Was it not three men we cast bound into the midst of the fire?" They replied to the king, "Certainly, O king." He said, "Look! I see four men loosed and walking about in the midst of the fire without harm, and the appearance of the fourth is like a son of the gods!" **Isaiah 6:5** My eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts. (see **John 12:41**)

JESUS IS.....

The last Adam **Romans 5:14** So also it is written, "The first man, Adam, became a living soul." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. **1 Corinthians 15:45** But the free gift is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many.

The better Abel **Hebrews 12:24** And to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks better than the blood of Abel.

The light of the world **John 8:12** Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."

Living Bread **John 6:49,51** Your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and they died....I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh.

The rock which was struck **1 Corinthians 10:4** and all drank the same spiritual drink, for they were drinking from a spiritual rock which followed them; and the rock was Christ.

Lifted up for salvation **John 3:14-15** As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up; so that whoever believes will in Him have eternal life.

The Final Sacrifice **Hebrews 10:11-12** Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins; but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God.

Judge **John 5:22** For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son.

Prophet **Hebrews 1:1-2** God, after He spoke long ago to the fathers in the prophets in many portions and in many ways, in these last days has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world.

Priest **Hebrews 4:14** Since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

King **Revelation 19:16** And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.
