Luke 2:7 And she gave birth to her firstborn son; and she wrapped Him in cloths, and laid Him in a manger.

Luke 2:52 And Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Matthew 4:2 He then became hungry.

John 19:28 I am thirsty.

John 11:35 Jesus wept.

John 4:6 So Jesus, being wearied from His journey, was sitting thus by the well.

Mark 15:27 And Jesus uttered a loud cry, and breathed His last.

Philippians 2:6-7 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,⁷ but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

1 Timothy 3:16 By common confession, great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh.

Hebrews 2:17 Therefore, He had to be made like His brethren in all things, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

Exodus 25:8 Let them construct a sanctuary for Me, that I may dwell among them.

Revelation 21:3 Behold, the tabernacle of God is among men, and He will dwell among them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself will be among them.

John 2:11 This beginning of His signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory, and His disciples believed in Him.

John 11:40 Jesus said to her, "Did I not say to you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?"

John 17:5 Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.

Matthew 17:2 And He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light.

Exodus 34:6 Then the Lord passed by in front of him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in lovingkindness and truth.

Mark 1:7 After me One is coming who is mightier than I, and I am not fit to stoop down and untie the thong of His sandals.

Micah 5:2 But as for you, Bethlehem...from you One will go forth for Me to be ruler in Israel. His goings forth are from long ago, from the days of eternity.

Colossians 1:17 He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

John 8:58 Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am.

Colossians 2:3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Colossians 2:9 For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form.

2 Corinthians 12:9 And He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is perfected in weakness." Most gladly, therefore, I will rather boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

Romans 6:14 For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

• He is _____ v17

Romans 3:19-20 Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are under the Law, so that every mouth may be closed and all the world may become accountable to God; ²⁰ because by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified in His sight; for through the Law comes the knowledge of sin.

Galatians 3:10-11 For as many as are of the works of the Law are under a curse; for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who does not abide by all things written in the book of the law, to perform them." ¹¹ Now that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, "The righteous man shall live by faith."

Galatians 3:24 Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith.

Psalms 85:10 Lovingkindness and truth have met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other.

Romans 5:20-21 The Law came in so that the transgression would increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, so that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God.

Hebrews 4:15-16 For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin. ¹⁶ Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Ephesians 6:24 Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with incorruptible love.

• He is _____ v18

Exodus 33:20 But He said, "You cannot see My face, for no man can see Me and live!"

1 Timothy 6:16 who alone possesses immortality and dwells in unapproachable light, whom no man has seen or can see. To Him be honor and eternal dominion! Amen.

John 6:46 Not that anyone has seen the Father, except the One who is from God; He has seen the Father.

John 14:9 Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father.

John 7:29 I know Him, because I am from Him, and He sent Me.

Colossians 1:15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.
