**Genesis 22:7-8** Isaac spoke to Abraham his father and said, “My father!” And he said, “Here I am, my son.” And he said, “Behold, the fire and the wood, but where is the lamb for the burnt offering?”<sup>8</sup> Abraham said, “God will provide for Himself the lamb for the burnt offering, my son.”

**Exodus 12:21-23** Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families, and slay the Passover lamb.<sup>22</sup> You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning.<sup>23</sup> For the Lord will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to come in to your houses to smite you.

**Leviticus 16:21-22** Then Aaron shall lay both of his hands on the head of the live goat, and confess over it all the iniquities of the sons of Israel and all their transgressions in regard to all their sins; and he shall lay them on the head of the goat and send it away into the wilderness by the hand of a man who stands in readiness.<sup>22</sup> The goat shall bear on itself all their iniquities to a solitary land; and he shall release the goat in the wilderness.

**Isaiah 53:7** He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth.

**Revelation 5:12** Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing.

## HIS REDEMPTIVE WORK

**Isaiah 53:11** He will bear their iniquities. **Matthew 20:28** [He gave] His life a ransom for many. **1 Corinthians 15:3** Christ died for our sins. **2 Corinthians 5:21** He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf. **Galatians 1:4** [He] gave Himself for our sins. **Galatians 3:13** Christ [became] a curse for us. **1 Timothy 2:6** [He] gave Himself as a ransom for all. **Hebrews 2:17** He might become a merciful and faithful high priest...to make propitiation for the sins of the people. **Hebrews 9:26** He has been manifested to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. **1 Peter 2:24** He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross. **1 Peter 3:18** Christ also died for sins once for all. **1 John 2:2** He Himself is the propitiation for our sins. **Matthew 1:21** He will save His people from their sins. **1 John 3:5** He appeared in order to take away sins. **1 John 4:14** The Father has sent the Son to be the Savior of the world. **Revelation 1:5** Jesus Christ...who loves us and released us from our sins by His blood.

**Psalms 32:1** How blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered!

**Micah 7:18** Who is a God like You, who pardons iniquity and passes over the rebellious act of the remnant of His possession? He does not retain His anger forever, because He delights in unchanging love.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**John 1:15** John testified about Him and cried out, saying, “This was He of whom I said, ‘He who comes after me has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me.’”

**John 1:27** It is He who comes after me, the thong of whose sandal I am not worthy to untie.

• He is \_\_\_\_\_ v32

**Isaiah 11:1-2** Then a shoot will spring from the stem of Jesse, and a branch from his roots will bear fruit. <sup>2</sup> The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.

**Isaiah 61:1** The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the afflicted; He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to captives and freedom to prisoners;

**Acts 10:38** You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

**Matthew 3:13-17**

**John 3:34** For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure.

• He is \_\_\_\_\_ v33

**Ezekiel 36:25-27** Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your filthiness and from all your idols. <sup>26</sup> Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. <sup>27</sup> I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.

**Titus 3:5-6** He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior.

**John 3:5** Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God."

**Romans 8:9** However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.

• He is \_\_\_\_\_ v33

**Psalms 2:7** I will surely tell of the decree of the Lord: He said to Me, 'You are My Son, today I have begotten You.'

**Isaiah 42:1** Behold, My Servant, whom I uphold; My chosen one in whom My soul delights. I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the nations.

**Matthew 17:5** While he was still speaking, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and behold, a voice out of the cloud said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to Him!"

**John 5:18** For this reason therefore the Jews were seeking all the more to kill Him, because He not only was breaking the Sabbath, but also was calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God.

**John 10:30** I and the Father are one.

**1 Peter 2:4** And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God.

3. \_\_\_\_\_ v35-37

**John 3:30** He must increase, but I must decrease.
