1. John the Baptist with _____ v35-39

- We preach Christ _____ v35-37

John 1:36 And [John] looked at Jesus as He walked, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God!"

1 Peter 2:24-25 The grass withers, and the flower falls off, ²⁵ but the word of the Lord endures forever. And this is the word which was preached to you.

Acts 5:20 Go, stand and speak to the people in the temple the whole message of this Life.

1 Corinthians 2:22-24 Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom; ²³ but we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness, ²⁴ but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

John 1:51 Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see the heavens opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man.
