## CAPERNAUM

**Matthew 4:13** and leaving Nazareth, He came and settled in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali.

**Matthew 9:1** Getting into a boat, Jesus crossed over the sea and came to His own city.

**Matthew 11:23-24** And you, Capernaum, will not be exalted to heaven, will you? You will descend to Hades; for if the miracles had occurred in Sodom which occurred in you, it would have remained to this day. <sup>24</sup> Nevertheless I say to you that it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment, than for you.

**Matthew 13:55-56** Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary, and His brothers, James and Joseph and Simon and Judas? <sup>56</sup> And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this man get all these things?

## PASSOVERS IN JOHN

**John 2:13** The Passover of the Jews was near, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

**John 5:1** (possibly Passover) After these things there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

**John 6:4** Now the Passover, the feast of the Jews, was near.

**John 11:55** Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and many went up to Jerusalem out of the country before the Passover to purify themselves.

## 1. Jesus denounces empty \_\_\_\_\_ v13-15

**Exodus 12:13-14** The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to the Lord; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.

**Exodus 30:13-14** This is what everyone who is numbered shall give: half a shekel according to the shekel of the sanctuary (the shekel is twenty gerahs), half a shekel as a contribution to the Lord. <sup>14</sup> Everyone who is numbered, from twenty years old and over, shall give the contribution to the Lord.

**Leviticus 22:18-19** Speak to Aaron and to his sons and to all the sons of Israel and say to them, 'Any man of the house of Israel or of the aliens in Israel who presents his offering, whether it is any of their votive or any of their freewill offerings, which they present to the Lord for a burnt offering— <sup>19</sup> for you to be accepted—it must be a male without defect from the cattle, the sheep, or the goats.

**Leviticus 5:7** But if he cannot afford a lamb, then he shall bring to the Lord his guilt offering for that in which he has sinned, two turtledoves or two young pigeons, one for a sin offering and the other for a burnt offering.

**Matthew 17:27** Go to the sea and throw in a hook, and take the first fish that comes up; and when you open its mouth, you will find a shekel. Take that and give it to them for you and Me.

**Malachi 3:1-3** "Behold, I am going to send My messenger, and he will clear the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, will suddenly come to His temple; and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you delight, behold, He is coming," says the Lord of hosts.

<sup>2</sup> But who can endure the day of His coming? And who can stand when He appears? For He is like a refiner's fire and like fullers' soap. <sup>3</sup> He will sit as a smelter and purifier of silver, and He will purify the sons of Levi and refine them like gold and silver, so that they may present to the Lord offerings in righteousness.

## 2. Jesus demands holy \_\_\_\_\_ v16-17

**Isaiah 66:1** Thus says the Lord, "Heaven is My throne and the earth is My footstool. Where then is a house you could build for Me?"

**Exodus 40:33-35**

**2 Chronicles 6:18, 7:1-3**

**Isaiah 6:1-5**

**Psalms 69:9** For zeal for Your house has consumed me, and the reproaches of those who reproach You have fallen on me.

**Isaiah 56:9** Even those I will bring to My holy mountain And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar; For My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples.

**Mark 11:15-18** Is it not written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations'? But you have made it a robbers' den. (also Matthew 21:12-13, Luke 19:45-48)

**Mark 3:5** After looking around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored.  
**John 11:33** When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews who came with her also weeping, He was deeply moved in spirit and was troubled.  
**Ephesians 4:32** Be angry, and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger.

### 3. Jesus determines eternal \_\_\_\_\_ v18-22

**Matthew 12:6** But I say to you that something greater than the temple is here.  
**John 4:48** So Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you simply will not believe."  
**Matthew 12:38-41** Then some of the scribes and Pharisees said to Him, "Teacher, we want to see a sign from You." <sup>39</sup> But He answered and said to them, "An evil and adulterous generation craves for a sign; and *yet* no sign will be given to it but the sign of Jonah the prophet; <sup>40</sup> for just as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the sea monster, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. <sup>41</sup> "The men of Nineveh will stand up with this generation at the judgment, and will condemn it because they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and behold, something greater than Jonah is here.

**Mark 14:58** We heard Him say, 'I will destroy this temple made with hands, and in three days I will build another made without hands.'  
**Matthew 27:40** You who are going to destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross.

**John 10:17-18** For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it again. <sup>18</sup> "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again.  
**John 12:16** These things His disciples did not understand at the first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written of Him, and that they had done these things to Him.  
**John 14:26** But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

**Matthew 13:20-21** The one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; <sup>21</sup> yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away.

- Jesus denounces \_\_\_\_\_ empty religion

**Isaiah 64:6** For all of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; and all of us wither like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.  
**Ecclesiastes 7:20** Indeed, there is not a righteous man on earth who continually does good and who never sins.  
**Romans 3:10** There is none righteous, not even one.

- Jesus demands \_\_\_\_\_ holy worship

**Galatians 2:20** I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.  
**2 Corinthians 6:16-7:1**  
**1 Corinthians 6:18-20** Flee immorality. Every other sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body. <sup>19</sup> Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? <sup>20</sup> For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.
