A. The Word of God is _____

John 5:26 » For just as the Father has life in Himself, so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself

John 14:6 » Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father except through Me.

1 Peter 1:24-25 » For, "ALL FLESH IS LIKE GRASS, AND ALL ITS GLORY LIKE THE FLOWER OF GRASS. THE GRASS WITHERS, AND THE FLOWER FALLS OFF, BUT THE WORD OF THE LORD ENDURES FOREVER." And this is the word which was preached to you.

John 6:67-68 » So Jesus said to the twelve, "You do not want to leave also, do you?" Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have words of eternal life."

Psalms 119:50 » This is my comfort in my misery, That Your word has REVIVED me.

Isaiah 55:11 » So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; it will not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.

Romans 1:16 » For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

A. The Word of God _____

Revelation 1:16 » In His right hand He held seven stars, and out of His mouth came a sharp two-edged sword; and His face was like the sun shining in its strength.

Ephesians 6:17 » And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Acts 2:37 » Now when they heard this, they were pierced to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?"

B. The Word of God _____

2 Timothy 3:16 » All Scripture is inspired by God and beneficial for teaching, for rebuke, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man *or woman* of God may be fully capable, equipped for every good work.

Colossians 1:28-29 » We proclaim Him, admonishing every person and teaching every person with all wisdom, so that we may present every person complete in Christ. For this purpose I also labor, striving according to His power which works mightily within me.

Revelation 22:18-19 » I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are written in this book.

2 Kings 19:27 » But I know your sitting down, your going out, your coming in, and your raging against Me.

Job 34:21 » For His eyes are upon the ways of a person, and He sees all his steps.

Proverbs 15:3 » The eyes of the Lord are in every place, watching the evil and the good.
